8	Autumn	Tudor England looking at the lives of Henry VII, VII, Edward the VI, Mary I and Elizabeth I. Focusing on religious change and the importance of each ruler. Assessments: Why did Henry break with Rome? Does Mary Tudor deserve the title 'Bloody Mary'?
	Spring	What is the Industrial Revolution and how did it impact on people's lives. How and why did England build up an Empire. What was the impact of the Empire on the World? Assessment: How did the Industrial Revolution change people's lives? Did everyone have a negative experience of the British Empire?
	Summer	What is slavery and what happened during the African slave trade. What are civil rights and how did people fight for them in America. Assessment: What was life like on a slave plantation? Who was most significant in the Civil Rights Movement?
